Applauds California Senate Vote  
SB 14 (Simitian) Moves to State Assembly**

**Sacramento, CA-** The Renewable Energy Accountability Project (REAP) applauds today's close vote in the State Senate passing SB 14 (Simitian), which would require all utilities, including municipally owned utilities, to procure at least 33% of the electricity they sell from renewable resources by 2020.

"This vote builds momentum for California to become the epicenter of the Energy Technology Revolution," commented S. David Freeman, Principal of REAP.

"SB 14 has passed the State Senate but much hard work remains. REAP will continue to monitor the progress of SB 14, and report on any attempt to water down its provisions," said Jim Gonzalez Chair of REAP.

"Today's vote in the State Senate is a major step in keeping California at the forefront of the nations new green economy," Gonzalez concluded.
